<p>Medical information card</p> <p>WHAT IS BLINCYTO® (blinatumomab)?</p> <p>BLINCYTO® is a prescription medicine used to treat adults and children 1 month and older with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • B-cell precursor acute lymphoblastic leukemia (ALL) in remission when only a small number of cancer cells remain in the body (minimal residual disease) • B-cell precursor ALL that has come back or did not respond to previous treatments • Philadelphia-chromosome negative B cell precursor ALL in the consolidation phase of chemotherapy treatment with multiple phases <p>ALL is a cancer of the blood in which a particular kind of white blood cell is growing out of control.</p> <p>It is not known if BLINCYTO® is safe and effective in children less than 1 month of age.</p> 	<p>IMPORTANT NOTE FOR HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS:</p> <p>Do not flush the BLINCYTO® (blinatumomab) infusion line or intravenous catheter, especially when changing infusion bags. Flushing when changing bags or at completion of infusion can result in excess dosage and cause complications. When administering via a multi-lumen venous catheter, infuse BLINCYTO® (blinatumomab) through a dedicated lumen.</p> <p>Please contact your prescribing provider with any questions that BLINCYTO® (blinatumomab) may cause serious side effects that can be severe, life-threatening, or lead to death, including:</p>
